Scholarships are considered on a case-by-case basis, and requests will be processed in the order they are received. Requests for waivers will not be accepted at the door.

Please note the following:

- Only a limited number of scholarships will be awarded.
- Applications are considered on a case-by-case basis and will be processed in the order they are received.
- To be considered for financial hardship scholarship discount, you must submit this application **along with the course enrollment form**, no later than **October 10, 2014**.
- The cost of the training will be reduced for each scholarship recipient, but it will not be eliminated because the total class enrollment fees must cover the costs incurred by Brigitte Schmidt Bell, P.C., including venue costs, materials, food, and trainer fees, and our intent is to keep the cost affordable for everyone.
- All requests for financial hardship consideration will be kept confidential.
